

International Hon-Do-Ryu Karate Organization (IHDR-KO)

Contribution and Fee orders

§1. Membership:

Only individuals can acquire the membership. While entering a nonrecurring fee is due to pay. The members receive IHDR-KO passes, their previous grade (Kyu / Dan) will be approved and they will be able to receive further grades within the IHDR-KO. The members will be given the chance to learn Hon-Do-Ryu Karate and to acquire instructor- and examiners-concessions.

But they can only bring to bear this concerning the learners who are as well members of the IHDR - KO.

Membership fees:

- Individuals pay a nonrecurring admission fee of **15 €**

§2.Examination-Principles within Hon-Do-Ryu

- 1.The examination of the student has to be conducted by its sensei.
- 2.The sensei permanently has to observe and correct the advance of his student.
- 3.Has the student matured, his sensei certifies him the assignment of a higher kyu- or dan-grade through an entry in the pass within an official ceremony.

The ceremony for the certification of the kyu-grades takes place on the following dates:

- 25 April
- 7 Nov

The ceremony for the certification of the dan-grades take place on the following date:

- 25 April

Note:

All of the examinations within Hon-Do-Ryu karate have to be approved on the basis of the examination-agenda and they have to be confirmed via a diploma by the IHDR-KO-chief-instructor.

§3. Examinations from other Organisations

Examinations from other organisations will be approved by the IHDR-KO-chief-instructor and confirmed in the pass under the entry “other martial arts” with the comment “carryover”.

The achieved grade can be approved within the Hon-Do-Ryu Karate by the IHDR-KO-chief-instructor if the particular instructor met the necessary trainingstatus for his grade according to the examination-agenda of the IHDR-KO.

§4. Examination-Fees

1.Examinations (the ceremonies for the certification of the kyu/dan-grades) can be carried out by membership-instructors of the IHDR-KO in their own schools so long they are authorized through their licenses.

2.Examination fees are fixed by each instructor for its own school.

3.Per Kyu-examination **5 €** are due to pay from the examination-fee to the IHDR-KO

4.Per Dan-examination **25 €** are due to pay from the examination-fee to the IHDR-KO.

§ 5. Licenses:

The Dan-grades assigned by the IHDR-KO automatically contain examiners- and Instructors-licenses.

1. Examiners-Licenses for Yudansha-Grades:

Yudansha-Grades are classifications from the 1. up to the 4. Dan.

- 1 - 2. Dan: can approve examinations of its own learners including the 1.Kyu.
- 3 - 4. Dan: can approve examinations including the 1.Dan.

2. Examiners-Licenses for Kodansha-Grades:

Kodansha-Grades are classifications from the 5. up to the 10. Dan and they carry the title Sensei/ Shihan/ Hanshi.

- Kodansha-Grades can approve examinations including the 2.Dan.
- From the 2.Dan on only an IHDR-KO-chief-instructor can approve examination.
- Kodansha-Grades and titles have to be acknowledged by the IHDR-KO-chief-instructor.

Note:

To achieve an instructor-/ examiners-license the aspirant has to be 16 years of age.

§ 6. Seminar-Fees:

For participating at a seminar (instruction- and advanced training courses) seminar fees will be raised. Seminar-Fees and –Dates are fixed by the organisers. Additionally **25 €** have to be paid for each seminar to the IHDR-KO independent from the number of participants. Seminars have to be applied for and approved by the Chief-instructor. Seminars may only be conducted by approved IHDR-KO instructors (Kodansha).
